## MyOSPRI is replacing eASD

### Purpose

This Advisory notice is to update transporters that the eASD system and its app are being retired. From 5pm 24 July 2022, any electronic Animal Status Declarations (ASDs) that transporters receive will be from [MyOSPRI](#), OSPRI's new online customer portal.

### Electronic ASDs will be briefly unavailable

Electronic ASDs will not be able to be sent from **7pm on Friday 22 July until MyOSPRI is live at 5pm on 24 July**. If transporting livestock over this weekend, transporters need to be aware that eASDs should be sent in advance or the paper form will need to be used, to avoid any infringement fines.

### Adding your details into MyOSPRI

To ensure a smooth transition to MyOSPRI, and to avoid any instances of transporters not receiving ASDs to their emails, OSPRI are trying to ensure they have the correct details of transporters who receive electronic ASDs.

OSPRI have provided a list of transporters already [uploaded into MyOSPRI](#). Please check and see whether your company is included. If it's missing, and you'd like it included, please fill out [this form](#) or email [MyOSPRI@ospri.co.nz](mailto:MyOSPRI@ospri.co.nz) with your company details and main email address.

### What transport operators need to do

1. Check the list in Appendix 1 of this Advisory. These are the operators [uploaded into MyOSPRI](#). If your company is missing, and you'd like it added into MyOSPRI, email [MyOSPRI@ospri.co.nz](mailto:MyOSPRI@ospri.co.nz) with your company details and main email address as soon as possible.
2. Please only use one email address per transporter despatch. If you have more than one, please ensure you provide additional information, i.e., *Greg's transport (Temuka)* [GregsTem@xyz.co.nz](mailto:GregsTem@xyz.co.nz), *Greg's Transport (Dunedin)* [GregsDun@xyz.co.nz](mailto:GregsDun@xyz.co.nz)

### **What is eASD and what is MyOSPRI?**

eASD is an online system for completing Animal Status Declarations (ASDs) for sheep, cattle and deer being sent to slaughter. From 24 July, OSPRI will be replacing the eASD system with MyOSPRI, OSPRI's new online customer portal.

MyOSPRI will allow farmers to create both farm-to-farm and farm-to-meat processor electronic ASDs. As part of the online process, a farmer is required to select the transporter transporting the livestock, and a copy of the completed ASD is sent to the transporter's inbox. Using MyOSPRI is voluntary, and the system isn't replacing paper ASD forms. Paper forms will also still need to be used to transport stock to and from saleyards.

It's important that all transporters currently receiving ASDs from the eASD system are aware of the changes and have confirmed their details with OSPRI.

### **NAIT Declaration to Livestock Transporter**

If you are not carrying a NAIT Declaration to Livestock Transporter that animals are tagged and registered, you will need to carry a paper or electronic copy of this declaration during transport to avoid a \$400 infringement fine per untagged animal.

As referred in our earlier advice 22 June, DK-31 Advisory – Animal Status Declaration, the Ministry for Primary Industries have told Transporting New Zealand they will be taking a more proactive approach to enforcement over the coming months.

### **Transition to MyOSPRI**

Farmers using eASD will be migrated over to MyOSPRI over the weekend of 23-24 July. Their details, locations and historic ASDs will be moved over to the new system, and they'll be sent a link to set a new password to access their MyOSPRI account.

The eASD system will remain live until Monday 8 August for any in-flight ASDs still needing to be processed by meat processing plants. However, no new ASDs will be able to be created in eASD. Electronic ASDs will not be able to be sent from **7pm on 22 July until MyOSPRI is live at 5pm on 24 July**. If transporting livestock over this weekend, transporters need to be aware that the paper form will need to be used, or eASDs sent in advance.

When MyOSPRI is live, farmers will be able to create both farm-to-farm and farm-to-slaughter ASDs. Just like the physical ASD form, they are required to fill out the transporter details and the Declaration to Livestock Transporter. Some transporters have already been uploaded into the system and can be chosen from a drop-down menu.
