BRIDGE REPAIRS ON SH2 - HPMV DETOUR ROUTES

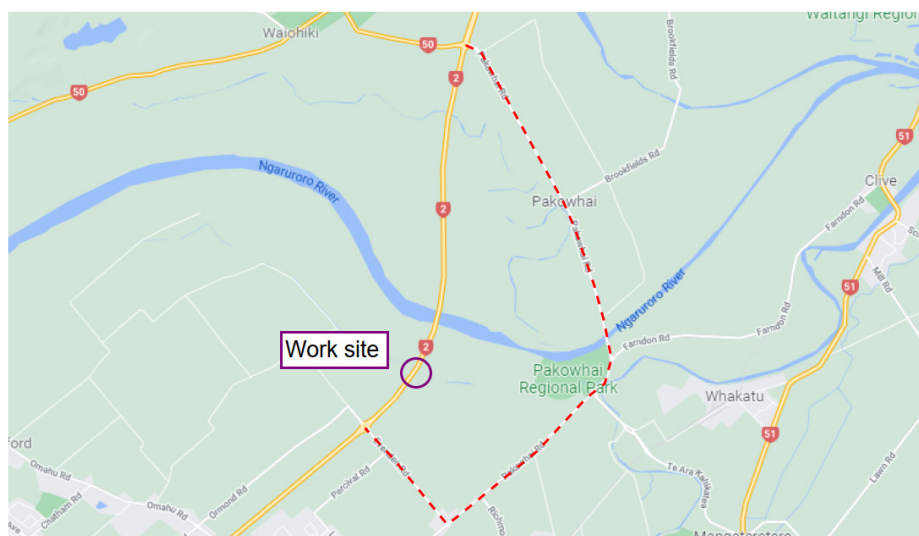
Night-time Road Closures, Friday 14th to Sunday 16th January 2022

Due to bridge repair works at Raupare Bridge on the SH2 Expressway, Hawkes Bay, there will be road closures requiring the use of detour routes on the above dates between 7pm and 7am (ie overnight). The state highway will only be closed in one direction each night. Traffic will remain on SH2 in one direction, with the traffic traveling in the opposite direction being detoured via local authority roads. At this time, the direction of the closure on each night has not been finalised, but this will be notified via advanced warning signs closer to the closure dates.

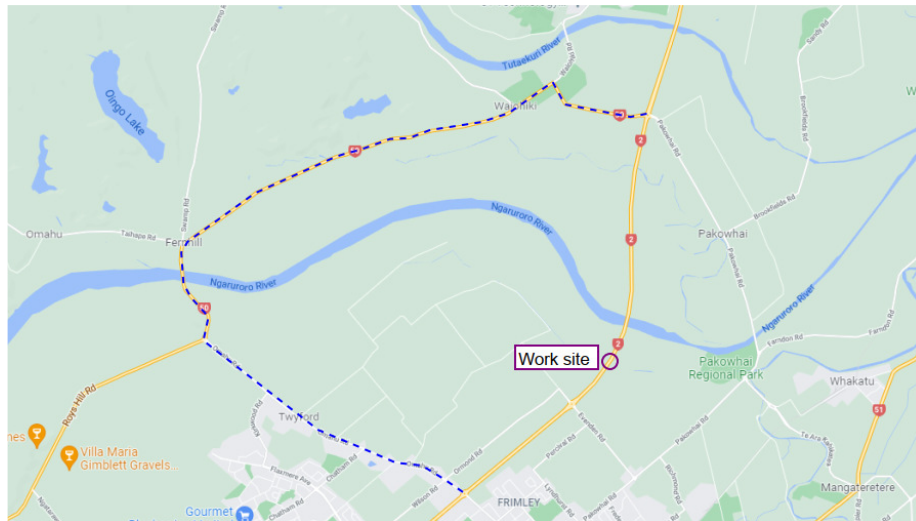
Closure of SH2 to Southbound Traffic

During the Southbound SH2 closure there will be 2 detour routes available to HPMV vehicles depending on destination:

- via Pakowhai Road and Evenden Road for HPMV's traveling into Hastings, as shown on the map below.

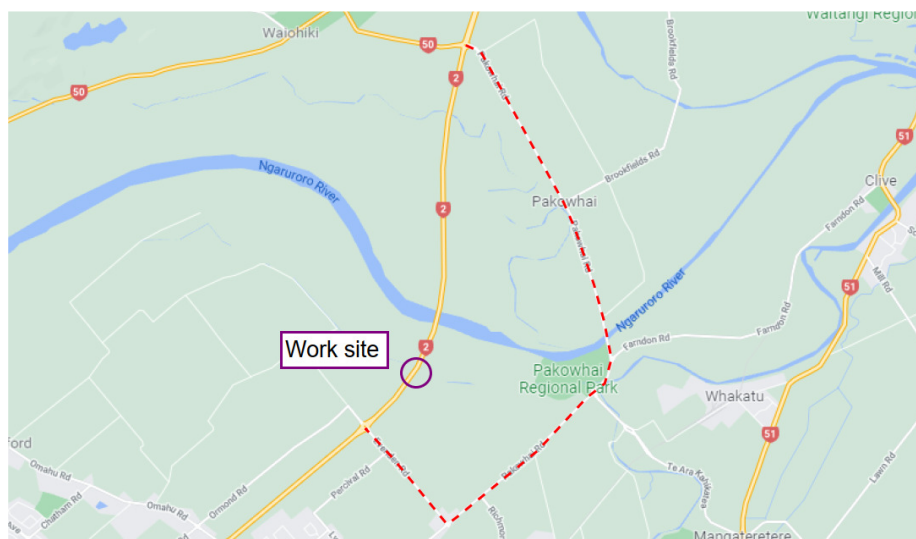


- via SH50 Links Road / Korokipo Road and Omaha Road, for HPMV's bypassing Hastings as shown on the map below. *Note that when using the SH50 detour route, HPMV's must cross the SH50 Fernhill Bridge over the Ngaruroro River at 20kph.*



Closure of SH2 to Northbound Traffic

During the Northbound SH2 closure there will be one HPMV detour route available, via Evenden Road and Pakowhai Road, as shown below.



Note: These times and dates are subject to change due to inclement weather, incidents, etc. Currently the weekend of the 21st to 23rd January has been proposed as an alternative date, should the weekend of 14th to 16th be unsuitable due to bad weather. However, this addendum is valid for whichever weekend these works are able to be carried out, to ensure these works can be completed without disruption to traffic.

Only these approved detour routes may be used unless other routes are already included on your HPMV permit.
