HPMV ROUTE DURING DESERT ROAD (RANGIPO-WAIOURU) TEMPORARY CLOSURE


Purpose

This supplements Advisory DK-44, Desert Road (Rangipo – Waiouru) Temporary Closure sent yesterday regarding the detour route around the western side of Mt Ruapehu via National Park while State Highway 1 between Rangipo and Waiouru is closed. Waka Kotahi has advised us today that the detour for High Productivity Motor Vehicles (HPMV) involves using SH 49, SH 4, SH 47, SH 41.

Key points

- The closure of SH 1 between Rangipo Waiouru will occur between 7am and 5pm on both Wednesday 9 and Thursday 10 November
- Unlike general access vehicles, HPMV cannot use State Highway 46 between Rangipo and Tongariro and should instead use SH 47 and SH 41.
- General access vehicles should detour to SH 46, SH 47, SH 4 and SH 49
- The different routes for HPMV and general access vehicles are shown on the map overpage.
- Please consider the impacts on your operations related to these detours.
